No end in sight ! The markets of TOCOM and SICOM further firmed during week 15, caused by firm crude oil and strong fundamentals. The future-market of TOCOM gained last week abt. 3 %, whereas SICOM RSS 3 jumped by almost 6 % and TSR 20 by abt. 2%. Latex grades such as TSR CV-60 and TSR CV-50 are almost unavailable for nearby shipments (May and June), caused by the tight raw material situation in the main growing areas of South East Asia. It is reported that in many regions dry weather prevents production after the wintering from a perceptible restart. Also in the coming weeks it is not expected to get any significant easing of the situation.

On Friday evening stock-exchanges already declined sharply when the US regulation authority SEC (Securities and Exchange Commision) sued Goldmann Sachs for fraud and analysts now expect billion dollar penalties against them. Most probably Goldman Sachs was not the only bank for which they detected for "irregularities". Bank experts now expect that the US government will intensify the regulation of finance-markets that could lead to smaller earnings of the banks.
