At the beginning of next week, Thailand will celebrate the Songkran Festival from the 13<sup>th</sup> of April to the 15<sup>th</sup> of April. Currently, there is low availability of raw materials in Thailand, coupled with firm prices.

In Vietnam, several producers have already started production, however, output is presently very limited due to hot and dry weather conditions.

Meanwhile, geopolitical developments have led to a weakening of the USD against other currencies. Additionally, paper markets have been highly volatile this week.
