The raw material situation remains tight, although there are first signs of production slowly improving. At the same time, however, buyers are becoming more active again, especially in China. This is creating additional pressure on the market.

Market participants are therefore facing increasing challenges in securing material although availability varies from grade to grade.

Another important factor is the strengthening of the USD, which is adding further upward pressure to pricing in Euro and other currencies. Overall, the market remains volatile, with uncertainty still dominating short-term developments.

Some news surfaced ex Indonesia where the governments seek to control the export of key commodities. As of now rubber is not included in this policy yet.
